EVENT OVERVIEW: GALLERY ARTISTS

Fifteen temporary “galleries” will showcase their fine art. Artists will be juried and selected to pair with local business venues in the historic downtown district of Corydon. All galleries are within easy walking distance of each other and all art work will be under cover from any inclement weather. Each artist will be required to provide their own docent to protect their work. Generous awards of \$1000, \$750 and \$500 (First, Second and Third Place) will be given.

EVENT OVERVIEW: BOOTH ARTISTS

Booth spaces will be located on the First State Capitol grounds along Beaver and Elm Street. Stakes for tents are not permitted on the grounds due to their irrigation system. We will have concrete blocks available for use if needed – please let us know if you would need these. A People’s Choice prize of \$300 will be awarded to the artist chosen by the public that day.

EVENT OVERVIEW: ALL PARTICIPANTS

The entire Art at the Old Capitol Festival will be actively promoted in all media to maximize the greatest possible support, attendance and exposure for all artists and the community. Food booths will be set up on a closed section of Elm Street between Chestnut and Beaver Streets. Music will be at Bicentennial Park and during the day by musicians at various locations in the downtown area. Art demonstrations and Children’s Activities will also be part of the day.

Application Requirements

Artist must submit completed application along with 5 images of their work and a 500 word biography.

Rules and Regulations

Fifteen artists will be juried, selected and notified. All mediums are encouraged. Organizers are looking for innovation and creative efforts that will charm and surprise, as well as being beautiful and/or topical. Artists are responsible for providing attractive staging for a significant body of work, including installation. All paintings must be framed. Sculpture is encouraged, but size and weight will be a part of the jurying process.

Artists must be present during the prescribed hours. Gallery set up will be Saturday, September 22nd, 2017 from 8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. Shows must be viewer ready by 11:00 a.m. Artists must provide their own docent/assistant. Artists are responsible for all sales. Artists are responsible for paying Indiana state sales tax to the Indiana Department of Revenue. Sold work cannot be removed until closure of the gallery - 7:00 p.m. - no exceptions.

Art at the Old Capitol will provide attractive artist info and signage for each venue along with maps for the gallery walk. Art at the Old Capitol will provide lunch for all artists. Upon acceptance, each artist will be provided further information on the event. Art at the Old Capitol reserves the right to photograph artist's work for promotional use only.

Judging

Three qualified judges will study each gallery exhibit and present cash awards at closure of the event. Presentation, creativity, and expertise will all be highly valued. Information on judges will follow upon acceptance to Art at the Old Capitol.

Awards

First place \$1000, Second place \$700 and Third place \$500 for Gallery Artists

\$300 People's Choice Award for Booth Artists

First place \$100, Second place \$75 and Third place \$50 for the Student Art competition.
